Additional Programs

Lunch Bunch

Our Lunch Bunch program is offered Monday through Friday for children who are enrolled in a morning or afternoon 3's or pre-k class. The program runs from 11:30-12:30. Morning students are taken to the Lunch Bunch classroom when class is dismissed. Afternoon children arrive at 11:30 a.m. and are escorted to their afternoon class by an MCPP teacher at 12:30 p.m. Each Lunch Bunch is staffed by two MCPP teachers. The children enjoy lunch together, free choice time and on occasion, extra playground time outside.

Special Events

During the course of the year, MCPP offers several cultural arts events/assemblies for the children's enjoyment. Puppet shows, Native American storytellers and exotic animals are a few of the exciting guests we have come to visit. These events really bring the curriculum to life for the children!

Enrichment classes are offered depending on enrollment and interest. Some classes we have offered in the past include Spanish, math games and eco-nature.

Our popular summer camp runs for 3 weeks, beginning the day after memorial day. Children have a great time with water play, arts & crafts, music and much more! Information about camp goes out in the spring.
